With unlimited access to visit your favorite animals, be sure to visit the newest exhibits including Tiger River, Gorilla Tropics, Ituri Forest, Polar Bear Plunge, Monkey Trails, Absolutely Apes and the Giant Panda Research Station. Water comes into play on 13 of the 27 holes with a spectacular waterfall surrounding the green of the signature hole.
